Philippians 4:15-17 Not that I desire your gifts; what I desire is that more be credited to your account."

Benefits of generosity to GIVER

- 1. Generosity generates growth (2 Corinthians 8:10-11, Proverbs 11:24)

- 3. You will grow in Love for the Kingdom of God (Matthew 6:21).

Benefits of generosity to RECEIVER

- 1. Generosity blesses others. (Phil 4:15-16)
- 2. Generosity extends the Kingdom of God through receivers. (Matthew 6:38)
- 3. Generosity brings glory to the Lord from the receiver. (Phil 4:20)
